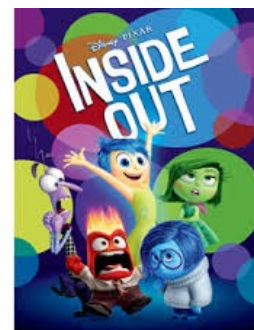

Financial Update through June Total income is \$251,344.67 or 44% of budgeted income. Total expenses are \$266,330.20 or 45% of budgeted expenses. Total expenses exceeded total income by \$14,985.53. In addition to general fund contributions, New Hope has received \$12,143.71 in designated contributions through May.
