Notes about communion procedures (for those worshipping in the sanctuary):

In this time of transition, we will share communion with prepared wafer and wine and/or grape juice. The wafer will be placed over the cup, so that they may be picked up together by the communicant. There are 2 tables; one in the center aisle and a table to the right in front of the altar. Please take note: the table in front of the altar has only grape juice with the wafer.

After the pastor shares the blessed communion with the virtual community, the pastor will then indicate it is time for the in-person community to rise and go to the table nearest you to pick up the wine and wafer. We encourage you to keep social distancing as you make your way to & from the tables.

We invite you to eat and drink at your seat. Place your used cup in the wastebasket as you leave at the end of the service.
