

## *FROM PASTOR GINNY*

### *POTLUCK WITH THE POLICE*

That is probably not a title we would expect to read for the Pastor's article for the newsletter! Yes, we are sponsoring a Potluck meal with the Police so that our relationships with the police can be strengthened. Why?

Being freed in Christ we are empowered to look beyond the church walls to the needs and concerns of the community. In preparing for my role as Chaplain for the middle school Free Ride event, my remarks for the large group gathering focus on what it means to be at one and the same time, saint and sinner. On the one hand we are so concerned just about ourselves. We think we're at the center of the world...it's 'all about me' syndrome (sinner). And yet, on the other hand, we are called holy by God, by what God has done and we are set apart to do God's work in the world (saint). It's not just about us as individuals, but about how God loves us together to support each other as the church community, so that we are called to transform the larger community for the good of, for the sake of the neighbor.



As we know the actions of the police have recently been under scrutiny, particularly in regards to black and brown skinned people. Questions have arisen how police deal with bias, how they are trained, etc. It has been a stressful time both within and outside the police force and the community. It's hard to be blue, hard to be black and brown. So New Hope along with the group regularly convened on the 1st and 3rd Thursdays, called Conversation in Come-UNITY (Kickball event sponsors), and representatives from the Howard County Police Community Outreach division are gathering for intentional conversation across the color and culture divide. It will be an excellent time for us to practice

our listening skills and it will be an excellent opportunity to get to know one another and build up our community. It's our work as the Body of Christ!

We encourage you to bring a favorite family recipe or a dish that represents your culture. The Potluck with the Police event will be held on **Thursday, November 16 from 6:30-8:30 pm**. There will be an Evite message sent from the Fellowship Team for you to RSVP.

Join us with an open mind and heart for what God will do in the midst. May the Holy Spirit bless this endeavor.



## E-GIVING


New Hope announces two new electronic means of establishing recurring and periodic giving which include “Give +” and give by “text.” **Give +** is an app that you may download from the app store using either an iPhone, Android phone, or tablet. Once the app is downloaded, simply follow the prompts to establish your account and the amount you would like to contribute. This is a free app, and may be used anywhere, anytime.



The give by “text” may be accessed by texting (410) 870-5209, and specifying in the message box the amount you would like to contribute. This message should include a \$ and the amount such as “\$5.” Within a few minutes after you send the text message, you’ll receive a text with a link to register. Simply click on the link and enter your cardholder name and credit or debit card information. Once your registration is complete, you will receive a text verification and a receipt via email. For future giving, simply send a text with the amount you wish to give, and it will process automatically! At this time, the give by “text” only allows for contributions to the General Fund; however, stay tuned as additional funds will be available in the near future. 

**Mental Health First Aid – Free Training**



Just as CPR helps you assist an individual having a heart attack – even if you have no clinical training– Mental Health First Aid helps you assist someone experiencing a mental health related crisis. In the Mental Health First Aid course offered by Grassroots Crisis Intervention Center, you will learn risk factors and warning signs for mental health and addiction concerns, as well as strategies for how to help someone in both crisis and non– crisis situation. The training is FREE for people who live or work in Howard County and are 18 or older. The Interfaith Partners of the Chesapeake pass on their thanks for the job well done by our collective group last month!!! They will stay in touch and are happy that we have our own EC Group evolving for environmental events. This month we are working with the Patapsco Heritage Greenway group to clean up the Patapsco Trail/Stream along Alberton Road. The cleanup is at 1000 on 11 Nov 2017. 
